It is now possible to confirm that Mr. Harris, a member of our senior leadership team, will take over the teaching and learning responsibility for this class. 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Emotionally Friendly School Status

I am pleased to inform you that we are engaging in the Emotionally Friendly Schools (EFS) programme. EFS is an initiative developed by Salford Educational Psychology Service in collaboration with schools. The aim is to promote positive emotional wellbeing in school and identify and support any difficulties that arise early. EFS focuses on 4 key areas:

- * Staff Wellbeing and School Ethos
- * Classroom Practice
- * Assessing Children's Needs
- * Supporting Individual Children

As part of this process we have been asked to collect data from children to help measure the impact. Children may be asked to complete a questionnaire or take part in group conversations to gain their views about how they think emotional wellbeing is promoted in school. Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

This week, the Standards and Testing Agency have confirmed details of the new Y4 Multiplication Tables check that becomes statutory for Y4 pupils during the next academic year. This year, schools are being invited to take part in a voluntary capacity. The check is delivered as an online, on-screen digital assessment and in line with the national curriculum, will test the children on their fast recall of multiplication facts. When completing the assessments, pupils will be given 6 seconds to enter a response to a given question e.g. 7 x 8 = ? . In school we will be using our maths lessons to help the children to become more confident across the multiplication tables up to and including 12. We would however ask that parents support by regularly practising quick recall at home and encouraging the children to log on to sites such as Mathletics, Hit the Button or other such games.
