Today, your child has come home with an Acceptable Use Agreement. This outlines expectations for behaviour online when in school on the internet and when using the internet on devices at home with their peers.

In school, we take the safety of children online very seriously and as a result, we use Smoothwall filtering, which prevents the children from accessing illegal and inappropriate material and also, through our monitoring system with Smoothwall, devices are monitored to ensure any searches or entries on school devices which are a cause for concern, are flagged to staff swiftly to ensure the safeguarding of children.
