## Class Transition Arrangements—September 2020

Due to the closure of the school earlier this year, we have been unable to complete our usual transition programme for children. This will be for a period of Wednesday 2nd September to Wednesday 16th September. On Thursday 17th and Friday 18th September, the children will then complete transition days to their new classes. We are confident that this approach will give all children the best possible return to school. Both these staff are familiar to the children and will provide the necessary support during this unusual time.

Mr. Matthew Taylor will be working across all year groups to provide intervention groups for children and provide staff release for Senior Leaders in school. We will, government guidance permitting, be holding parent meetings early in the Autumn term. Prior to the summer break, teaching staff will be completing transition meetings to pass on necessary information to the receiving teachers, they will also meet early in the Autumn term to discuss next steps in each child's learning.
