Transition Arrangements

As communicated in our 'Dates for your Diary' section, children currently in Y1 to Y5 will complete transition days on 15th and 16th July. Due to the current COVID restrictions in school, we have reviewed our induction procedures for our current Nursery and Reception children. Our Reception children will complete two half day visits on the same days as the children in Y1 - Y5. The children in our current Nursery who are transitioning to Reception, will take part in visits during Thursday 8th and Friday 9th June. During these days, the Reception staff will also visit the children within the current Nursery setting.

Procedures for Reporting Positive COVID Cases During Whit Holiday

Today, the school will close for the Whit break. It is important to share procedures with parents of children who may currently be waiting to take a test, or are awaiting results, or if they become symptomatic during the holiday period and finally if they or a household member receive a positive result from a test during the holiday period. If any of these situations arise, I would be very grateful if you could continue to follow the process of informing the school via the school email. To facilitate this process, we have made arrangements for the broadoak.primaryschool@salford.gov.uk email to be monitored daily throughout the Easter period. By continuing to let us know if your child or family members test positive, we can update records and notify and advise any close contacts with regards to the length of isolation and the date that your child/close contacts can end isolation. Should your child receive a positive result, you should inform us as outlined above and follow the Stay at home: guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) infection. Should your child be identified as a close contact of someone who has tested positive within the school, you will be contacted by school and informed about the requirement to isolate. Please check your emails daily throughout the holiday.

Message from Salford City Council

Salford City Council is responding to complaints from families and residents about illegal, dangerous and inconsiderate parking near schools and is now using CCTV cameras to catch offenders, as well as regular patrols. The penalty is £70.00, reduced to £35.00 if payment is made within 14 days.
