At Broadoak, we are proud to have a strong musical ethos within school. Salford's Music and Performing Arts Service (MAPAS) offer a superb music service with peripatetic instrumental tuition for individual pupils, whereby children are given the opportunity to play a musical instrument throughout the year.

We offer a range of musical tuition: clarinet/flute/recorder, drums, guitar, piano/keyboard and violin. In some cases, we have instruments in school that pupils may borrow free of charge (mainly flute and clarinet) – please ask for details.

The cost of these lessons need to be met by parents and the charges next year will be held at £5.50 - £8.00 per week, depending on the length of the tuition session and number of pupils per session. All payments <u>must be made half-termly in advance</u> via ParentPay.
