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Nasal Flu Vaccination Programme

On Wednesday 20th October, we are once again taking part in the Nasal Flu Vaccination Programme. Pupils in Reception to Year 6 are eligible for the vaccination. In order to streamline organisation of consent, we will be running an online link for parents to complete. Please could we ask **ALL** parents to complete this straight away to allow sufficient time to feedback numbers to IntraHealth who will be coordinating the programme. The deadline for completion is **Monday 20th September**.
