## Pedestrian Training

On the 18th and 19th of October, Y5 and Y6 children will be participating in pedestrian training. This is an initiative run by Salford Council to train the children in crossing roads safely, in particularly at junctions and between parked cars. The sessions will also reinforce all aspects of road safety. As the children in these year groups gain more freedom when walking to and from school or playing out unaccompanied in the community, it is essential that road safety is revisited and understood.

The sessions will be led by two instructors and children will go out into the local community with them and school staff. Permission letters have already been sent home but unless they are returned by 15th October, children will not be able to participate in these sessions. Please send permission slips back into school as soon as possible. Thank you.

## **COVID Outbreak Management Procedures**

Unfortunately, this week we have had 5 children receive positive COVID results. Due to 3 of these being within Y3, we have been instructed by Salford Public Health to put in additional restrictive measures, within this year group. Salford Public Health recommend that when a positive case occurs, that all children within the year group or who have been identified as a possible contact, complete a PCR test. Thank you to all those families who have supported us this week and taken the children as requested. I would like to clarify with parents that this is an essential measure in identifying asymptomatic cases and will be a vital strategy under the new guidelines in supporting school to remain fully staffed and open to all children.

## National Poetry Day - Thursday 7th October

On Thursday 7th October, we will be celebrating National Poetry Day. The theme this year is Choice and we will be doing a range of activities with the children in class. We are asking children to bring in their favourite poem or book of poems to share with their class, if they would like to do so.
