COVID Vaccination for 5 - 11 year olds

As part of our weekly DFE update, it has now been confirmed that the COVID vaccination programme will be extended to include 5 to 11 year olds. The information provided is as follows:

Healthy 5 to 11 year olds will be offered the COVID-19 vaccine from the beginning of April. Vaccinations will take place outside of school, in vaccination centres, pharmacies, GP surgeries and walk-in centres. Parents of 5 to 11 year olds will receive a letter from the NHS with further information on the vaccine. For 5 to 11 year old and 12 to 15 year old vaccinations, parents can use the following link, where they can [book COVID-19 vaccination appointments online](#), at a vaccination centre or pharmacy, or [find a walk-in COVID-19 vaccination site](#) without needing an appointment. Bookings will open up for 5 to 11 year olds from the beginning of April.
