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COVID Guidance Update

Public health advice for people with COVID-19 changed from 1st April. Whilst there is now no legal requirement to isolate, guidance remains that anyone with symptoms should stay at home and away from others to avoid passing on the virus. From 1st April, anyone with a covid symptoms are advised to stay home and avoid contact with people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice is avoid contact with people for 3 days. School will be operating within this guidance and are therefore asking parents to follow the 3 day rule. The updated list of key symptoms are as follows:

- A new continuous cough
- A high temperature
- A loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell shortness of breath
- feeling tired or exhausted / an aching body
- a headache
- a sore throat
- a blocked or runny nose
- loss of appetite
- Diarrhea or feeling sick or being sick
